The next meeting of the Executive Board will be held on Saturday 24 September in Barcelona. The Council of National Representatives will be held in Room K4 Congress Centre, Barcelona on Monday 26 September, during The World Conference of Surgical Patient Care.

On-line Journal – There have been unavoidable delays to the publication of the first on line journal, however it is hoped that the first issue will be on-line in February 2006.
